As veterans, what are some trends you've observed in regard to couples and wedding planners?

Having been in the industry for more than a decade, we notice that couples today are not simply looking for wedding planners who can style a wedding – just about anyone can do that, including the bride. Above and beyond styling, what modern couples are after are a team of skilled consultants and planners who are equipped with not only the right attributes to create a beautiful wedding, but also the right attritude to manage the complexities of planning one.

The latter spans a whole gamut of items, including managing clients' expectations; ensuring positive family dynamics and breaking up tension (if any); designing visually-arresting aesthetics; and handling all aspects of vendor relationships and banquet operations. We believe that the combination of all these elements will make up an unparalleled, stress-free wedding experience for the couple and everyone involved.

What are some of the challenges couples face these days when it comes to planning their wedding?

In this day and age, parents are increasingly getting involved in their children's wedding planning process - as opposed to five years ago when couples were more independent during the planning or purchasing stage. That's why we always pre-empt our couples that there may be differences between them and their parents should there be opposing expectations – the earlier the couples acknowledge this possibility, the smoother the planning process will be. What about the challenges you face as wedding planners?

Some of the tasks we have to fulfil would probably warrant others to mobilise an army of fairy godmothers to create miracles!

Many people are not aware of the high level of intensity and stress involved in planning a social event, particularly a wedding – the amount of energy and attention required to plan a wedding is enormous. Without the right support and proper management, the build-up of emotions and expectations can be frighteningly overwhelming.

What tips would you give to couples looking to engage a wedding planner?

Very simply put, when a couple chooses a planner, they have to be upfront with their expectations between bride and groom, as well as between the couples and the parents; be realistic with what can be achieved, and finally learnt to let of their doubts, and leaving the planning to the people - wedding planners, bridal gown designers, florists, photographers, makeup artists and so on - to whom they have entrusted their wedding.

Of course, as the planners, we must also be upfront about our capabilities from the get-go. One of the things we would never do in our company is over promise - we have to be diligent in managing the various levels of logistics needed to create the wedding we have been envisioning for our couples. Inevitably, a wedding is a reflection of the host as well as their planner.
